First Aid

First Aid:INHALATION-IF USER EXPERIENCES BREATHING DIFFICULTY, MOVE TO AIR FREE OF VAPORS. ADMINISTER OXYGEN OR ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION UNTIL MEDICAL ASSISTANCE CAN BE RENDERED. DON'T INDUCE VOMITING. CALL POISON CONTROL CTR, HOSP. EMERGENCY ROOM OR PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. SKIN-WASH WITH SOAP/WATER. EYES-FLUSH WITH WATER FOR 15 MIN. IF IRRITATION PERSISTS, GET MEDICAL ATTENTION.

Extinguishing Media: CARBON DIOXIDE, DRY POWDER OR FOAM Fire Fighting Procedures: SELF-CONTAINED RESPIRATORY PROTECTION SHOULD BE PROVIDED FOR FIREFIGHTERS IN BUILDINGS OR CONFINED AREAS.

Accidental Release
