Accidental Release

Handling

Handling and Storage Precautions: COMBUSTIBLE. VERY SLIPPERY ON FLOORS. AVOID EXCESSIVE HEAT. DO NOT STORE NEAR AMINES. IF DUST/MOLTEN, WEAR MECHANICAL RESPIRATOR & PROTECTIVE CLOTHING.
