## Accidental Release

Spill Release Procedures:VENTILATE AREA. REMOVE ALL SOURCES OF  
IGNITION. CLEAN UP AREA W/ABSORBENT MATERIAL & PLACE IN CLOSED  
CONTAINERS FOR DISPOSAL.

## Handling

Handling and Storage Precautions:STORE/USE IN COOL/DRY/WELL-VENTILATED  
AREAS. DON'T STORE >120F. AVOID CONTACT W/SKIN. DON'T TAKE
