Fire Fighting

Handling

Other Precautions: EQUIPMENT OR MATERIALS INVOLVED IN PESTICIDE FIRES MAY BECOME CONTAMINATED. DO NOT STORE NEAR ANY MATAERIAL INTENDED FOR USE OR CONSUMPTION BY HUMANS OR ANIMALS.
