Extinguishing Media:FOAM, CO2 & DRY CHEMICAL
Fire Fighting Procedures:TREAT AS CYLINDER OF COMPRESSED GAS. WATER MAY BE INEFFECTIVE. WATER MAY BE USED TO KEEP FIRE EXPOSED CONTAINERS COOL.
Unusual Fire/Explosion Hazard:DON'T SPRAY NEAR OPEN FLAMES. KEEP AT ROOM TEMPERATURE AS EXPOSURE TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT OR OTHER HEAT MAY CAUSE BURSTING.

Accidental Release

Spill Release Procedures:VENTILATE AREA. REMOVE OPEN FLAMES & SOURCES OF IGNITION. PICK UP W/INERT ABSORBENTS.

Handling

Handling and Storage Precautions:KEEP AWAY FROM HEAT, SPARKS, OR OPEN FLAME. STORE AT TEMP Other Precautions:KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN. DON'T SPRAY NEAR FIRE OR OPEN FLAME.

Exposure Controls
